Tavistock Town Council invites the local community to join them for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee Beacon Ceremony. There is a longstanding tradition in this country of celebrating royal jubilees, weddings and coronations by lighting beacons. Our beacon was last lit on Whitchurch Down as part of a chain of 1,000 beacons for Her Majesty's 90th birthday in 2016. Tavistock will be joining communities across the Commonwealth with one of more than 1,500 beacons across the world.
