No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the sections of Affected Roads.

Roads affected -

**KING STREET, MARKET STREET, WEST STREET, BEDFORD SQUARE, DUKE STREET,
BROOK STREET, ELBOW LANE, TAVISTOCK**

The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via - WEST STREET, FORD STREET, DRAKE
VILLAS, PLYMOUTH ROAD, ABBEY PLACE, DOLVIN ROAD, VIGO BRIDGE

Between the hours of **14:00** and **21:00**

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to park, wait, load or unload on the sections of
Affected Roads.

Roads affected - **KING STREET, MARKET STREET, WEST STREET, BEDFORD SQUARE,
DUKE STREET, BROOK STREET, ELBOW LANE, TAVISTOCK**

Between the hours of **15:00** and **21:00**

The One-Way system on the Affected Roads will be reversed.

Roads affected – **RUSSELL STREET (between Garden Lane and Plymouth Road)**

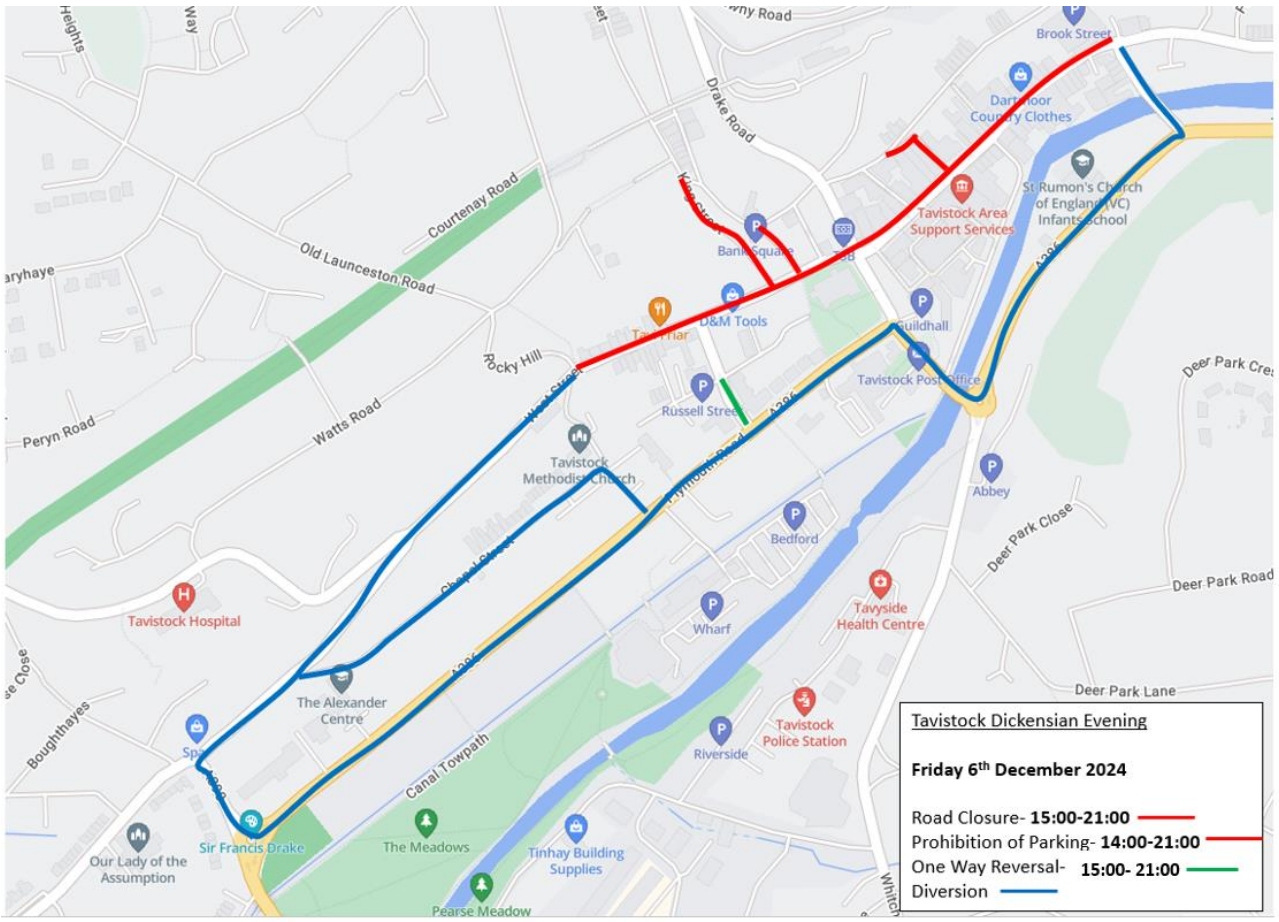

The map displays the following road management details for the event:

- Road Closures (15:00-21:00):** Indicated by red lines, these include sections of Courtenay Road, Old Launceston Road, and parts of the main thoroughfares near the town center.
- Prohibition of Parking (14:00-21:00):** Also indicated by red lines, this covers areas around Tavistock Methodist Church, the Tavistock Post Office, and the Tavistock Area Support Services.
- One Way Reversals (15:00-21:00):** Indicated by green lines, these are implemented on several streets to manage traffic flow during the event.
- Diversions (Blue lines):** These routes are shown for traffic that cannot use the closed roads, primarily utilizing the River Tavy and the Canal Towpath.
