


TRAIL 1: Tavistock Abbey Walk

There are 10 points of interest for this trail, all very close to the town centre, guiding you around the Abbey that was founded here in about 974AD.

 The route for this trail is about ½ mile.


TRAIL 2: Tavistock and the Dukes of Bedford

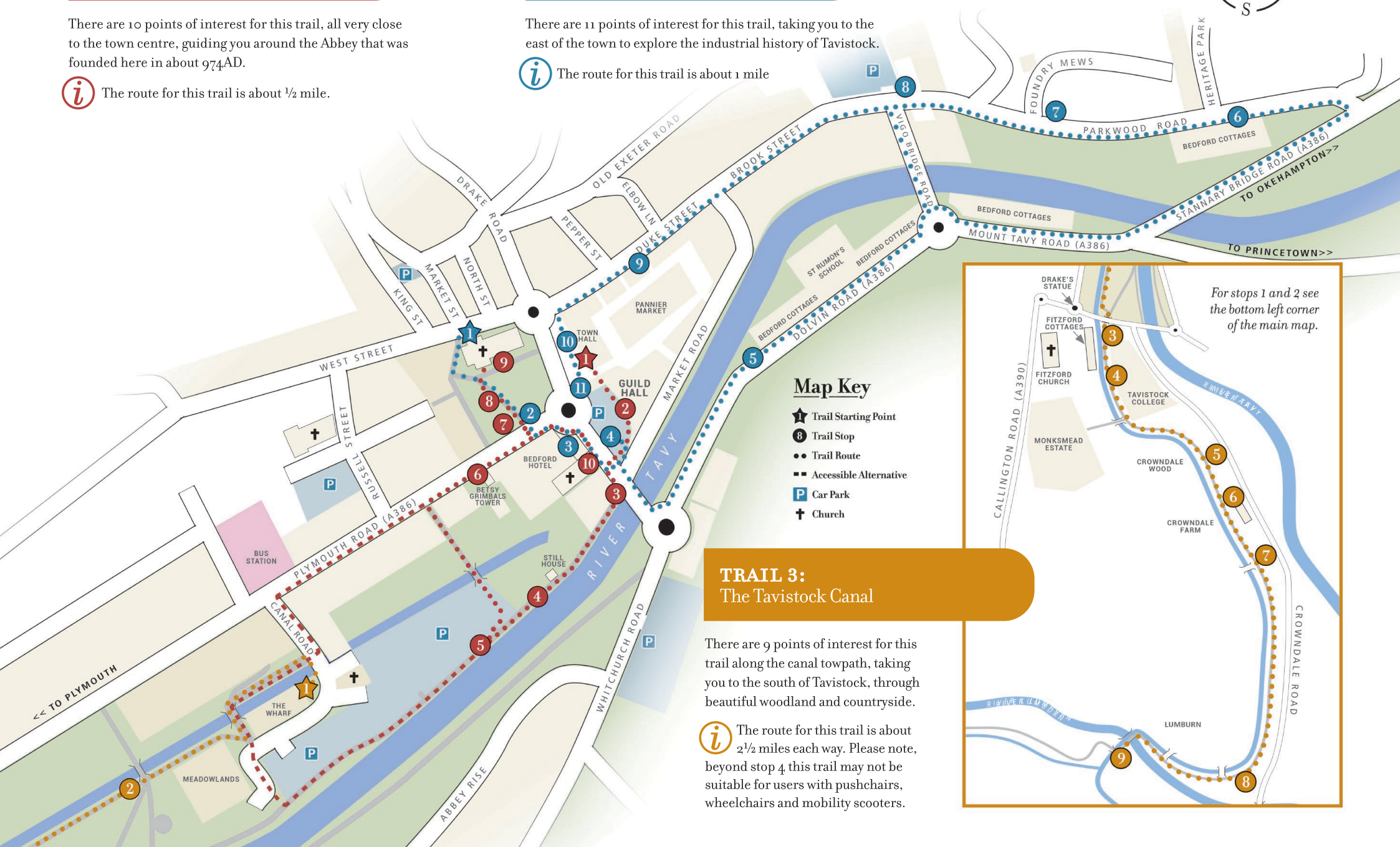
There are 11 points of interest for this trail, taking you to the east of the town to explore the industrial history of Tavistock.

 The route for this trail is about 1 mile

TRAIL 3: The Tavistock Canal

There are 9 points of interest for this trail along the canal towpath, taking you to the south of Tavistock, through beautiful woodland and countryside.

 The route for this trail is about 2½ miles each way. Please note, beyond stop 4 this trail may not be suitable for users with pushchairs, wheelchairs and mobility scooters.
