





TAVISTOCK, LIONS - WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO!

We are a Club of 50 members, easily recognised by our red shirts, who are community minded and proud to be members of Lions Club International, the largest non-governmental service organisation in the world. Our Tavistock Club was

formed or "chartered" in 1976 and we now meet on the second Monday of the month in the Tavistock Community Football Club building at Langsford Park. The motto of all Lions Clubs is "We serve" and that is what we do, by organising fund-raising events such as Carnival, detailed in this programme and our professionally fired firework display, the proceeds of all being distributed to local charities and good causes. We also try to help make Tavistock a great place in which to live – and have fun ourselves in doing so!!

BUT THAT'S NOT ALL.

Last year we ran a Christmas postal service where Club members and friends delivered almost 4,000 cards around Tavistock & Whitchurch. We also sold calendars and Christmas cards and accompanied Father Christmas and his elves to local primary schools delivering presents, which had been kindly financed by a donation from Tavistock Athletic's Club. Our main fund raiser over the Christmas period is our wonderful Trees of Light on the front of the Town Hall. We started with one tree in 1999 but after a few years, the scheme was so popular that this was increased to three. The lights are sponsored by individuals or families in memory of departed loved ones or special occasions and since the start 26 years ago, we have raised around £170,000 for local charities and good causes. We are indebted to local funeral directors, Morris Bros. (Tavistock) Ltd. for their generous sponsorship over the years.

BARBEGUES We love to barbecue and we have a great reputation for high quality food and great service. We not only cater for our own events such as Carnival Fun Day and Fireworks, but also support other organisations such as Tavistock Ruby Club, Tavistock Community Football Club, Tavistock Steam Fair, local schools and many others. Our most successful event is Dickensian Evening when we serve around 1,000 units in 4 hours. Unfortunately, outdoor stalls and food outlets were cancelled last year due to bad weather but hopefully we will be back this year. We are very grateful to Palmers Butchers here in Tavistock for their supply of high-quality burgers and sausages.

ROAD MANAGEMENT With our long-established reputation for traffic management, we often support local organisations such as the Town Council, Scouts and the British Legion with road closures and we know that on Remembrance Sunday this is very much appreciated by the public. We also maintain the traffic island close to the entrance to Bishopsmead and most of the daffodils that can be seen in the Spring around the town have been planted by Club members over the past 50 years.

UKATIVE Since the beginning of March 2023, Club members have made 10 trips to Warsaw taking much needed humanitarian aid for onward transportation into Ukraine. It costs around £1,400 to take each van; this increases by £500 if we have to hire a van so when Sovereign Wines and Fairway Furniture have very kindly loaned us vans, this makes a real difference.

Town Council benches were refurbished back in 2024 by Men in Sheds, with the costs covered by the Club. Both benches have been designated as Chatty Benches. The idea is that if you choose to sit on one of these benches, you will be quite happy for someone, perhaps a stranger, to join you for a chat hence the name. There are plaques on the benches showing a QR code that takes you to the Lions Club website, which contains several useful links to sites about mental health awareness.






